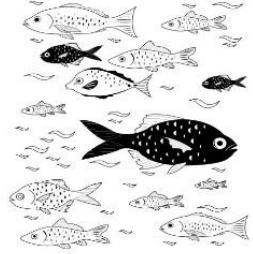

**Retiring Collection for Coco's Foundation** - Sue and John Knight are going to KwaZulu Natal, South Africa with Coco's Foundation again on 16 May. The women and young girls have no access to female sanitary products so at certain times they will just sit on a piece of cardboard or anything else they can find because they are too embarrassed to go out. Especially for the girls, it means staying away from school and missing their education. Coco's are linking up with another charity "Days for Girls" who make re-usable products. The girls are given a drawstring bag with 8 fabric pads, 2 liners, 2 pairs of pants, a flannel and a bar of soap. The cost of the complete kit is £5. Sue and John will be taking out the fabric for the kits and also teaching the girls how to make them so that they can sell them to make them self-sufficient. We are having a retiring collection today to help fund the project. It is hoped that we, as a church will give ongoing support.
